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Watching Critically: Survey & Critique of Short Documentary Movie

(Please form a group of two to three people.)

Watch the movie objectively and critically:

- 1. Try to characterize/describe it. How does this determine or relate to the overall style of the movie? (Use of color or B & W, sound, texture, voice, etc.)
- 2. What documentary style is used?
- 3. What is/are the implied message(s)?
- 4. Who is the intended audience?
- 5. How is the content organized?
 - Analyze the sequence or order in which the story is presented.
 - How does this sequence effect the movie's impact?
- 6. How are transitions between clips or scenes handled? How do these affect the pace? How are type and voice-over narration used? How do they relate?
- 7. How is music used? How does it relate to the images and the transitions between them?
- 8. Why is this movie successful? How could it be improved?

Presentation duration: 5-10 minutes per group

It would be good to show us a short (30 sec to 1 min) clip from the movie to give us an idea what you are talking about

A simple written report (not less than 200 words, you can include images / screen shots)
